1. Summary description of the pilot action explaining its experimental nature and demonstration character

The pilot activity in Kujawsko-Pomorskie is different from other partner regions, because it is non-investment undertaking. The aim of activity is preparation of 3D visualisation model of historical park area in the region. Trough development of 3D model, tool for self-evaluation process will be tested.

The visualisation is based on detailed revitalisation studies embracing i.a. analysis of the historical spatial composition, park revalorization concept and plants inventory. The purpose of the study is to make an inventory of the existing state, including location and boundaries, relief, forest stand, road system, small architecture and its remains, presentation the history of the object, conducting a historical analysis of the spatial composition and finally developing a concept of park revalorization.

The visualization was made in the form of a two-minute film presenting historical and current photos and a spatial image of the future park. Thanks to visualization, we can walk through planned park alleys; look at plants, trees and infrastructure elements (buildings, fountain).

2. Describe stakeholder engagement and involvement during the whole process

Representatives of regional university, parks owners, culture institutions, experts were involved in the process of pilot preparation. The 3D visualisation was a result of revitalisation concept prepared for the Park in Wieniec. The concept was consulted with the experts from the Marshal's Office as well as with Musical Theatre – the owner of the park and palace complex. The presentation of the concept and 3D visualisation is planned during the final event.

3. Investment location (NUTS 3 region(s), adress, postal code, city, country)

The 8-hectare Park and Palace Complex in Wieniec is located within the urban-rural commune of Brześć Kujawski in Kujawsko-Pomorskie voivodeship. The historical borders and spatial arrangement of the complex have been preserved. The park composition is clearly visible in the basic





elements of the old plan and, most importantly, the entire complex maintains its character of a mansion built by Kronenberg in the second half of the 19th century. The complex in Wieniec is one of the most palatial locations of this

kind that still exist in Kuyavia. The area of the Park and Palace Complex currently includes the new palace, the old palace, the gatehouse with the entrance gate and the old technical building.

One of the main outputs of the Hicaps project was preparation of Electronic 3D visualisation model of historical park area in Kujawsko-Pomorskie region. The chosen location of the pilot – Park in Wieniec is supervised by the Kujawsko-Pomorskie self-government and managed by the Kujawsko-Pomorski Music Theatre in Toruń.

4. Description of the investment, including technical characteristics

The pilot does not concern the physical investment.

5. Which horizontal principles did you take in consideration during preparation and implementation process (equal opportunities, non-discrimination, economic aspect, barrier –free accessibility,)

During planning process, the principles concerning accessibility for different groups of people, including removing barriers for handicapped and elderly people were considered.

6. Duration and process of investment implementation

The pilot does no concern the investment

7. If applicable, compliance with relevant regulatory requirements

In this phase, there was no need to compliance and regulations.

8. Major milestones

a) Elaboration of the framework programme of conservation and restoration works embracing the brick fence, gatehouse, fountain-reconstruction.





- b)In terms of landscape architecture preparation of stand inventory and management.
- c) In terms of landscape architecture preparation the project of planting.
- d) In terms of architectural design preparation the concept of revitalisation/development of the area with the existing buildings.
- e) In terms of communication preparation the concept of park's paths (excluding access roads embraced in the construction project.
- f) In terms of water supply and sewage systems preparation the concept of fountain revitalisation.
- g)In terms of energetic branch preparation the concept of lanterns arrangement and power supply for open air events.
- h) Elaboration of 3D visualisation embracing the part of the park area, in the surroundings of the new and old palace, up to the line of compact trees (including the western glade with the fountain, southern glade from the gatehouse up to the southern part of the palace, eastern part of access road, the area between old and new palace). The visualisation should be scaleable, adjusted to the mobile phones. Model will implement historical facts, having promotional and educational dimension.

9. Investment costs in EUR

The total cost for the concept and 3D visualization was 14 860,17 EUR

10. Ownership and durability of the investment (e.g. maintainences, financing)

The chosen location of the pilot – Park in Wieniec is supervised by the Kujawsko-Pomorskie self-government and managed by the Kujawsko-Pomorski Music Theatre in Toruń.

Currently no permanent employer of the Kujawsko-Pomorski Music Theatre works at the Park and Palace Complex in Wieniec. According to the plans of the modernization project, ultimately over a dozen persons will be employed there. Their jobs will be related to the function and needs of the object, involving care and support of the audiences and guests, technical support of





events and general care of the place. At present there are no documents that provide a detailed management plan or include securing the Complex.

11.Expected impact and benefits of the pilot action for the concerned territory and target groups

At the moment an investment concerning the renovation the historical palace is being carried out in the park area. Some of spatial and planting solutions coming from the revitalisation study can be already implemented together

with ongoing investment process. However, it is assumed that the appropriate realization of the revitalisation study and the spatial concept elaborated within the Hicaps project, will be carried out during the next phase (future EU programming period).

Therefore the expected impact and benefits of the pilot action for the territory and target groups is difficult to estimate at the moment.

12. Lessons learned from the implementation of the pilot action

An important element of the study is a reference to the history of a particular place and an attempt to recreate the unique value. The challenge was a recreating historical elements that should be associated with the planned function of future objects.

Transnational cooperation brings many benefits to the concept, i.e. it showed organizational, infrastructure and social solutions in order to establish an interesting place for citizens.

13. Transferability to other territories and stakeholders

The prepared concept and assumption for park revitalisation can be easily transferred to other territories. The documents and visualisation will be available for external users.

14. Added value of transnational cooperation
