


Fields of impact of municipalities and other bodies in the Transport sector

MISSION STATEMENT/MOBILITY CONCEPT



- Anchoring sustainable mobility in the municipality's Mission Statement and in its self image!
- Joint agreement on aims and implementation steps
- Embedding in programmes and plans:
 - in political strategies, documents and papers
 - E.g. transport development plans, mobility masterplans, mobility strategies and etc.
- Consequent involvement of citizens
- Cooperation with neighbour municipalities

MISSION STATEMENT/MOBILITY CONCEPT



Definition of final targets:

- Long term implemention of sustainable mobility
- Specific local measures
- Involve as many stakeholders as possible
- CO² reduction





MOBILITY TEAM



Installing a Mobility Counsellor, Mobility Coordinator or/and a Mobility center

Further important stakeholders:

- Politicians (mayor etc.)
- Heads of departments
- Officials, Employees (e.g. works council)

ANALYSIS OF EXISTING SITUATION



Mobility survey:

- Actual Mobility behaviour modal choice
- Individual needs and wishes
- Personal and technical requirements for sustainable modal choice
- Suggestions of improvement

On-site inspection:

- Traffic situation/conditions
- Infrastructure

Research:

- Legal framework
- Grants and supports
- Experiences with projects in this area

PLANNING MEASURES



Important for the development of measures fostering sustainable mobility behaviour:

• Low-threshold access:

Measures need to be integrated into the daily routine easily Measures and mobility offers need to be well prepared

- Developing a catalogue of measures:
 - Information and awareness raising
 - Measures fostering walking
 - Measures fostering cycling
 - Measures fostering public transport
 - Regulation of car use in the municipality
 - Fostering car pooling and sharing
 - Fostering e-mobility with 100% renewable energy

PLANNING MEASURES



- Distribution of tasks somebody who is responsible!
- Defining timescales for completing tasks!
- Representatives of the municipality act as role models!

IMPLEMENTATION OF MEASURES



- Implementation according to the catalogue of measures
- Accompanying all measures with public relations work
 - Service area on municipal homepage
 - local newspaper etc.
- Process is being observed and evaluated especially the mobility team has the possibility to control and suggest corrections in the process
