

ASSESSMENT of RI RELEVANCE - TOOL



The Assessment of RI Relevance aims at identifygin which RI themes (ethics, gender equality, governance, open access, public engagement, science education) are more relevant to a specific organisation.

The Assessment of RI Relevance stands as a simplified assessment of materiality, reflecting the organisation's impact and its power of influence and capacity to bring change by influencing internal and external stakeholders.

The final version of the Assessment of RI Relevance is an output of the Train-The-Trainer Capacity Building session.
