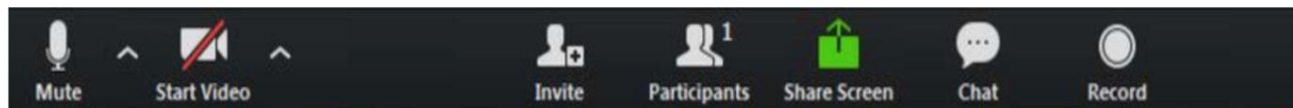

Participant controls in the lower left corner of the Zoom screen:
